Centennial Year Kick Off Mass

Parish Oral Histories & Video Time Capsule

We are interviewing and recording conversations with 15-20 parishioners to collect their experiences and memories of parish life. These will be edited into a series of perhaps three or four 10-minute podcasts and put on our web site during the course of the Centennial Year. Some of the material from these oral histories will also be used for the Centennial publication.

In addition, during the course of parish and Centennial events over the next 12 months, we will do 3-minute video recordings of parish members to record the following: family introductions, how long they have been in the parish, how they participate in parish life, and what they like about the parish.

These will be edited into one video and put on our web site.

Called and Gifted Workshop Featuring Sherry Weddell

A co-founder of the Saint Catherine of Siena Institute in Colorado Springs, CO, Sherry Weddell is known throughout the world for her publications and workshops that foster and equip parishes to become centers of evangelization and formation. Paying Tribute to Saint Pius V Veterans

World War II Roll of Honor

The generation of Saint Pius V parishioners who served in World War II is truly remarkable. Saint Pius V parish, a relatively small neighborhood parish in the 1941-1945 World War II era, sent over 330 men and women to serve! Fathers, sons, brothers, daughters, sisters, aunts and uncles from virtually every street in the parish left their homes and families to fight for our country.

We recently discovered a 4' x 8' wood door in the basement of the priory that was re-purposed during the war to serve as a list of the Saint Pius V men and women who served in the war. It is called the World War II Roll of Honor. This particular remembrance plaque is, however, too large to display anywhere in the church and in too bad a shape to restore. We would like to re-create the Roll of Honor with a new walnut perpetual plaque with new name plates at a size of perhaps 3' x 4'. It would be permanently mounted in the Parish Hall or at the rear of the Church. We are looking

to mount the completed plaque on Memorial Day 2018. Sixteen of the three-hundred and thirty-eight names on the plaque are shown below.

We will also be seeking parishioners to lend us photos of family members who served in WW II so we can have the unveiling of the plaque accompanied by a small publication with photos of some of our parish WW II service people.

Project Needs: 1) Small committee of 5-8 parishioners to see this project through; 2) Sponsor(s) to underwrite the cost of the plaque and the publication.

World War II Memorial Plaque

Three hundred and thirty-eight Saint Pius V parishioners served in World War II. Six parishioners paid the supreme sacrifice for their country and did not return home to their families and to Saint Pius V. These six individuals are remembered in a small bronze plaque that was installed after World War II on the back wall in what is now the corner of the school gym. We would like to restore the plaque and re-install it to a more prominent position next to the new World War II Roll of Honor on Memorial Day 2018.

Project Needs: 1) World War II Roll of Honor committee to see this project through.

Parish Outdoor Sign

A committee has already been formed to design and install a long-needed sign for the front lawn of the church to reinforce



the Saint Pius V parish presence in the community. The sign will complement the existing architecture of the church and be lighted at night.

Saint Pius V Parish Cookbook

The 75th anniversary of the parish featured a very popular recipe book. Providence is known as a “foodie town”, so it is only fitting that we publish a Centennial Cookbook. The Centennial Cookbook will incorporate many of the favorites from the 75th version but will include new recipes from veteran and new families to the parish, reflecting the many wonderful cultures represented in our parish. We hope to sell this recipe book for \$10 to help defray the printing costs, but a sponsor would also be delightful. But hey, maybe this book will go viral on the internet and we’ll have a new parish ministry.

Centennial Publication

We would like every parishioner to have a publication that marks and celebrates the 100 years of the Saint Pius V parish. The publication will include photos of past events of the parish, family photos related to parish events, photos of the Centennial events, and the history of the parish and the school. Our goal is to make this publication free for every parish family and to do this we will need to have sponsor pages and perhaps an overall sponsor.

This publication would be completed and distributed in December 2018, a couple of months after the Centennial Anniversary Mass.

Project Needs: 1) A committee of 4-6 people to help pull together this project; 2) A sponsor to help underwrite the cost of the publication.
